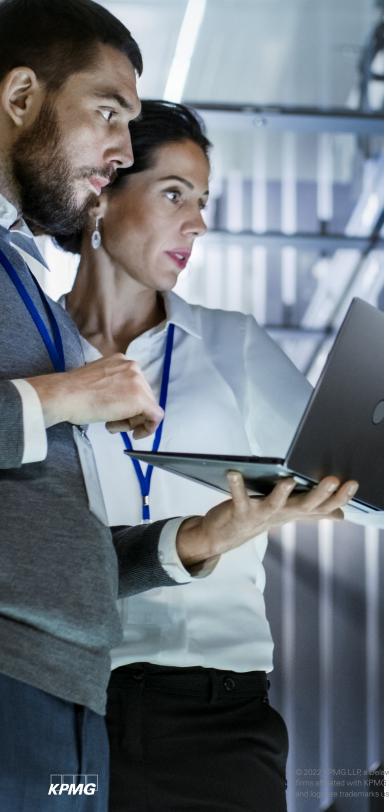

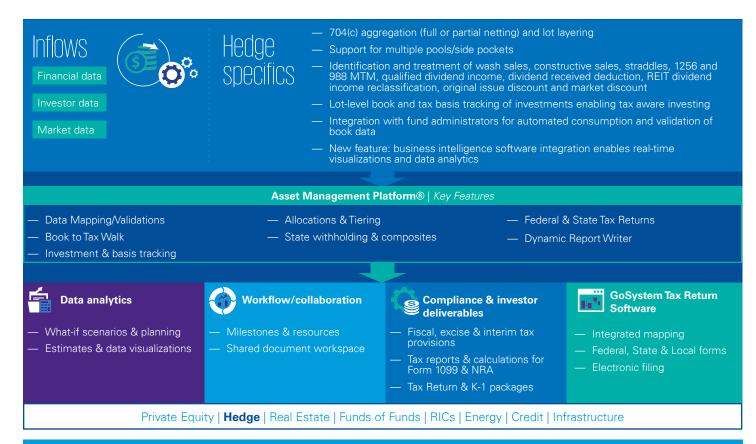

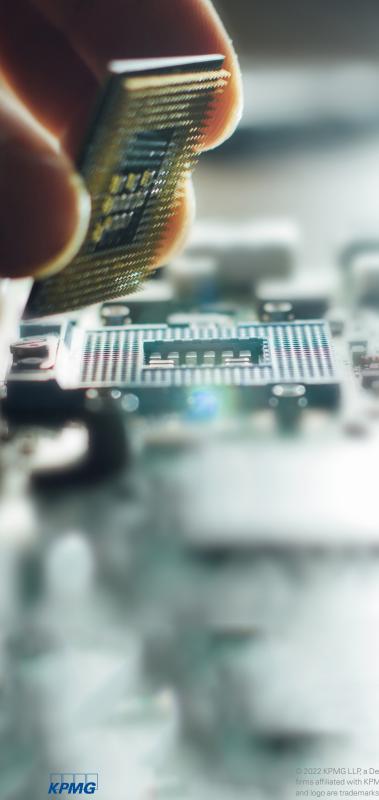

Securities Analyzer functionality

Securities Analyzer enhances the Asset Management Platform by performing tax analysis of securities transactions, automating the associated book-to-tax adjustments necessary for tax compliance and enabling tax efficiency investing.





Securities Analyzer inflows

- Beginning-of-period holdings Security master
- Purchases and realized G/L
- End-of-period holdings
- Corporate actions
- Prior-period adjustments

Securities Analyzer trade analysis

Wash sale:

Applies IRC Sec 1091 to calculate loss deferral and reversal on substantially identical securities or options to acquire the same. The analysis incorporates IRC Sec 988 bond bifurcation netting rules.

Constructive sale:

Applies IRC Sec 1259 to calculate and track deemed sale events on appreciated financial positions. The analysis considers daily trade activity.

Straddle:

Applies IRC Sec 1092 to calculate loss deferral and reversal on offsetting positions. Integrated basis tracking avoids duplication of loss deferral with wash sales and other tax adjustments. Supports identified and unidentified straddles.

Securities Analyzer dividend analysis

Qualified dividend, dividend received deduction:

Analyzes dividend payments for preferential tax treatment qualification under IRC Sec 1(h)(11) or IRC Sec 243

Calculate REIT dividend and basis adjustment:

Automates the calculation of return of capital gain, long-term capital, and IRC Sec 1250 amounts paid on REIT securities; tracks basis adjustments on securities sold and calculates the appropriate gain or loss

Short dividend analysis:

Analyzes when a payment made in lieu of dividends on a short position requires a cost basis adjustment under IRC Sec 263(h) and tracks the effect of such adjustment on wash sales, constructive sales, or straddles

1256 Contracts:

Applies IRC Sections 1256 & 988 accordingly to calculate mark-tomarket and realized gain/(loss) on futures, options and forwards.

Securities Analyzer debt analysis

Key features:

- OID, market discount, and bond premium computations
- Debt with multiple embedded put and call options
- 988 income bifurcation of total gain/loss into 988 and non-988 gain/loss on disposition of principal
- Accelerated principal payments

Elections:

- Taxpayer level {bond premium offset; market discount as accrued}
- Securities instrument level {CYM; all-OID}

Coming soon:

- Variable-rate debt instruments
- Multiple scheduled principal payments
- Notional principal contracts analysis
